Released in January 1968 the HK was touted as a new generation Holden, was built on a longer wheelbase, had more interior space and a V8 engine was offered for the first time. The new huge array of factory options resulted in over 2 million options. In July 1968 a range of Monaro coupes was introduced from the base Monaro, a 186 'S' six cylinder Monaro GTS with a 307 V8 option and Monaro GTS 327, the latter being a Bathurst winner. The flagship of the HK range was the Brougham, released simultaneously with the Monaro. It was Holden's answer to the Ford Fairlane. The HK Holden was available in 13 different models - Belmont sedan, wagon, panelvan and ute; Kingswood sedan, wagon and ute; Premier sedan and wagon; Brougham; Monaro coupe, GTS coupe, GTS 327 coupe.

The two-millionth Holden (2MH), an HK Brougham, was produced at Dandenong on March 3rd 1969.
