- 1. Samba for violin, flute, clarinet, strings, piano & percussion written Sydney 1949, dedicated to Neville Amadio
- 2. The Duke of Perth for piano, violas & 'cello
- 3. Trauermusik 63 for viola solo, 3 violins, cello and keyboard written to commemorate the death of President Kennedy. Includes sketches.
- 4. Quintet for flute, oboe, bassoon, viola and piano (1962)
- 5. Sonata for violin & piano (1960): Andante, Serenade, Adagio
- 6. Prelude, Marche & Valse, Opus 1 for piano (same as 39)
- 7. Manuscript sketches: Waikiki (song with words by Rupert Brooke), Jumpin' Pumpkins (piano arrangement of Duke Ellington piece) & sketch of Poem for 2 violins & piano
- 8. Manuscript sketch: *Berceuse* for violin & piano (1950)
- 9. An Die Nacht und das Gestin for voice & piano with text by Martin Opitz, (1965, Zurich)
- 10. Two French Folksongs, *Ah! Vous dirai-je maman*! and *Au clair de la Lune* for choir, vocal score (1965)
- 11. Ms of Beauvais *O Lovely Restless Eyes*, for voice & piano, text translated from the Latin by Helen Waddell (1958)
- 12. Ms of St Remy at Rheims for voice & piano (1958)
- 13. 'The Burial of the Dead: Hymnus circa Exsequias Defuncti' for alto voice & piano, text translated from the Latin of Prudentius by Helen Waddell (Summer 1957, Zurich)

- 18. Two Poems by Verlaine for soprano & piano (according to title: only music for one Poem) (1962, Gawler, as per cover)
- 19. Student sketch book: *Take thou this Rose –Hommage a Ravel* and sketch of Poem for 2 violins and piano (ca.1947?)
- 20. Sketches for Adagio for string orchestra (complete score in pencil, part score in ink.)
- 21. *Jiddische Lieder* for voice & piano (1964)
- 22. Improvisations for viola & piano: The Torn Picture Book & A Story (1955)
- 23. Second movement of unspecified work for violin & viola, tempo poco adagio rubato (1959)
- 24. Sketches of *Spanish Dance* for 3 violas





- 25. Country Fiddler for string orchestra, written for the Staatliche Musik-Kommission, Basel (1980)
  - 26. A Sonnet by William Shakespeare: *Shall I compare thee...*for voice & piano (1966)
  - 27. Sing a Joyful Song, for chorus, solo quartet & piano duet, choreographic part-song in the style of a spiritual, words & music by B. Langbein (1964, Zurich)
  - 28. Two pieces: March & Song for viola & piano, 1952, revised 1957)
  - 29. *Memories from Childhood* for violin & piano (1952)
  - 30. The Fields of Sorrow for voice & piano, in 2 different keys, with text translated from the Latin by Helen Waddell (May 1955, Rennweg 19)
  - 31. Sketches of arrangements for violin & piano: Abendlied (Schumann), Prelude from Langbein's Opus 1 Suite, & Valse in C# minor (Chopin) transposed to D, violin part only.
  - 32. The Lord's Prayer for four part women's voices a capella
  - 33. Three songs for soprano voice and string quartet: The Fields of Sorrow, Ms of St Remy at Rheims, & Ms of Beauvais O lovely restless eyes. Includes program notes from Zurich concert, 19 May 1980.
