



## GREENWOOD, family

W. G. Greenwood managed Beltana Sation for a while in the late nineteenth century, and began prospecting for various minerals c.1898.

About 1910-1911 he prospected radio active deposits in the North Flinders Range for the Mt. Painter Radium Extraction Co. Gordon Arthur Greenwood worked with his father at Mt. Painter, and was later associated with several pastoral properties in the Far North, including Mount Serle and Arkaroola. He was a member of a syndicate formed to mine talc in the Flinders Range, and was interested in other minerals such as ochre.
