Papers of the Glover family, including Charles Peter Glover, his wife Hannah, his son Charles Richmond John, and his grandson Charles John.

Charles Peter Glover came to South Australia from Richmond, England in 1855. He was the owner of the Plough and Harrow. Hotel (later the Hotel Richmond) from 1859.

Charles Richmond Glover was six times Lord Mayor of Adelaide and twice Mayor, a member of the Adelaide City Council for 27 years and Grand Secretary of the Grand Lodge of Freemasons for a similar period. He was prominent in the activities of the S.A. Navy League, the Adelaide Children's Hospital and numerous charities and a noted collector of books, especially Australiana.

For additional biographical material on C.P. and C.R.J. Glover see series 21 and 32 respectively.
