

Alfred Thomas Saunders was born at Queenstown, S.A. in 1854. He lived in Adelaide at 'Omagh', Hill Street, North Adelaide at least during the period 1913-1915, and possibly before this time.

In 1915 he moved to Perth, Western Australia, and worked at the 'Sunday Times Publishing Co. Ltd until his return to Adelaide in 1928. During this period he had several of his stories and letters published.

During his lifetime Saunders published several articles, books and pamphlets, including several on Bully Hayes. He died in November 1940.
