Harold Edward Winterbottom (1879-1953) was associated with the S.A. Chamber of Manufacturers for 40 years and was General Secretary for 25 years, From 1908 he was Secretary of Industrial Exhibitions and from 1915-18 Secretary of S.A. Soldier's Funds. He also established the first Australian Council of Management and inaugurated the Employers' Mutual Assurance Ltd. and the Journal of Industry. Upon his retirement as Secretary of the S.A. Chamber of Manufacturers, Winterbottom was appointed Chief Migration Officer, first in West Germany, and later in Holland.

Harold Winterbottom was married in 1902 to Alice Francis, daughter of Walter James Francis and a descendant of George William Francis. Their daughter, Barbara Joyce Winterbottom was married in 1945 to Darell Darbourn Best.
