MAYO, Dr George PRG 69

George Mayo, born on 8th January 1807, studied under Herbert Mayo, founder of the Middlesex Clinic, and became a member of the Royal College of Surgeons, London, in 1829. After practicing for some years in Wiltshire, he emigrated to South Australian in 1837 as a surgeon of the ship *Lady Emma*. He later returned to England, but again travelled as surgeon superintendent on the *Asia* in 1839. He practiced his profession in Adelaide until his retirement, becoming one of Adelaide Hospital's surgeons by 1849. He was appointed to the Hospital Board in 1853, a position he retained until his resignation in 1885. In 1851 he became a Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons, London/

As well as his medical interests, Mayo became a member of the volunteer militia of the Province. In 1859 he was appointed Captain of the West Adelaide Rifles, and was subsequently promoted to Major and late Lieutenant-Colonel.
