Friedrich Eduard Heinrich Krichauff was born in Schleswig, Denmark, in 1824, He was educated at Husum and at the University of Kiel. He arrived in South Australia in the "Alfred" on the 6/12/1848.

Until 1866 he farmed his property in the Bugle Ranges and was very active in Local Council Administration. In 1866 he moved to Adelaide and set up as a land agent, continuing to be involved in politics. He was elected to the House of Assembly seat of Onkaparinga in 1870 and served as a member until 1882, when he resigned to visit Europe and the United States. In May 1870 he was Commissioner of Public Works. From 1884 - 1890 he held the seat of Victoria. 1890 - 1893 he held the Southern District seat in the Legislative Council.

He retired from politics in 1893, spending the next years until his death in 1904, writing articles and pamphlets on agricultural topics.

The botanist and the politician in F.E.H. Krichauff combined to make him a strong force in matters of land use. He initiated the establishment of a forest board in 1875 and was Chairman of the Central Agricultural Bureau 1888 -1902. He also served on the council of Roseworthy Agricultural College. He had a close friendship with the botanist F. von Mueller. (See Series 2)

This record group was handed to the Archives by Mrs. Peter Anderson of Delamere in 1986. It consists of personal correspondence and personal papers (Series 1-8), business correspondence and business papers (Series 9-22), and official documents administered by F.E.H. Krichauff. (Series 23-32). The records of his wife - Dorothea Arwolina Sophia, nee Fischer (Series 33-47), and of his sons - Alfred Theodor, Edward William, Friedrich Charles and Sophus Henry (Series 48-62) relate mainly to the administration of the family properties after the death of F.E.H. Krichauff.

The papers of this record group have been arranged and translated when appropriate, by B.A.D. Lipscombe, Graduate Diploma student at the School of Library and Information Management, SAIT.
