1907. 1.5 cm 1 volume and 1 page
Inventory compiled after the 1906 division of the original
Bungaree holding. It provides a detailed room by room
listing of the furnishings and contents offered for sale
within the family, together with prices realized and initials
of the Hawker family members who purchased them. Also
includes implements and items from Hutt River and
Anama, dogs from Tierneys Camp, saddles and horse
gear. Volume has label: 'Mr Richard Hawker/Messrs H.C.
and R.M. Hawker/Inventory/Bungaree' A separate page
lists 'items passed for public auction', 4 April 1907. This
item has been digitized.
- Book used to house accounts for E.W. Hawker's education at 31
Trinity College, Cambridge University. The volume seems
originally to be used for lecture notes, over which were
pasted accounts from the university and general provision
merchants in Cambridge. A few pages record in his
handwriting the bills from his tutors & other expenses
1869-1873. The first 37 pages were later ripped out.
