Murray District was established in 1924. Wynarka Mission was changed to Karoonda Mission in 1924. In 1929 Karoonda, Peebinga Line, Alawoona and Paringa Line together with Kalyan and Copeville formed the Karoonda and Murray Lands Mission. In 1932 Karoonda and Murray Lands Mission was divided and Karoonda constituted a circuit consisting of Karoonda, Wynarka, Borrika, Sandalwood, Lalirra, Yurgo and Marama. Lowaldie had been added by 1942. Marama was discontinued in 1950 and Lalirra no longer listed by 1954. Copeville was transferred to Karoonda circuit in 1966.

ACCESS: All records may be accessed by researchers, with the exception of records which have been designated by the Uniting Church Archivist (as an authorised officer of the Church) as restricted. There is no access to restricted items without the written permission of the Uniting Church Presbytery and Synod, or the Uniting Church Archivist. Access to entries in baptismal registers after 1974 restricted for 75 years; access to entries in marriage registers after 1974 restricted for 60 years; access to entries in burial registers after 1974 restricted for 25 years. Access to later entries is restricted to the individuals named in the records or their authorised representative, and requires written permission from the General Secretary of the Uniting Church Presbytery and Synod, or the Uniting Church Archivist. Once written permission has been obtained please contact Coordinator, Content Services at the State Library to arrange access.

COPYING for private research and study is permitted for any records that are: not subject to an access restriction; already in the public arena (eg programs for Church services and special events, newsletters, pew sheets, church histories and photographs); and more than 30 years old.

PUBLICATION of a substantial amount requires written permission from the General Secretary of the Uniting Church Presbytery and Synod, or the Uniting Church Archivist. Quotation by scholars from documents more than 30 years old, and not specifically restricted, is permitted provided the source is fully acknowledged.
