It merged with the Adelaide Chamber of Commerce in 1972 to form the Chamber of Commerce and Industry, South Australia Incorporated. In 1993 the Chamber of Commerce and Industry, South Australia Incorporated, amalgamated with the South Australian Employers' Federation to form the South Australian Employers' Chamber of Commerce and Industry Incorporated.
