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Northcote Home at Grange was built by Sir Josiah Symon in 1928 for the care of mothers and babies. In 1941 the Home became a tuberculosis preventorium where children were cared for while their parents were recovering from tuberculosis. In later years as the incidence of tuberculosis became less a number of children from distressed homes were cared for.

Because of the increasing costs the Home was closed on 24 December 1973 and was later sold to the Mental Health Services Department.

Series 13, 14 and 15 are restricted. Series 13 and 14 refer to the medical history of families; series 15 includes comments on some parents and their home lives. These series are not to be used without the approval of the Archivist or Deputy Archivist.
