Founded early in 1882 as the I'Zingari Rowing Club, the records of the club start with the minutes of a meeting on 16 May 1882 at which it was decided to proceed with the construction of a boatshed. This was formally opened on Saturday 22 July 1882, and the club held its first race on 27 February 1883. At a meeting on 2 February 1885 the club was renamed the Adelaide Rowing Club.

All the club's equipment was destroyed by flood in April 1889 and the present "flood-proof" clubhouse was opened on 14 December, 1889.
